



# Angelina Ballerina's Shining Star Notepaper

Every ballerina princess deserves her own, personalized stationery. Let your ballerina take center stage by making her own notepaper and turn thank-you-note writing into a joyous event!

*The following activities are designed for parents and children to do together. Supervision of your children with materials such as glue, scissors, small jewels, etc is strongly recommended.*

**Time: 20 minutes**

**To create Angelina Ballerina's Shining Star Notepaper you will need:**

- One sheet 8.5" x 11" white paper
- Pencil
- Ruler
- 50 sheets assorted color paper... or just pink!
- One thin sharpie marker in black
- Photocopier (a trip to the local copy shop may be in order)
- Scissors or paper cutter (a paper cutter at a local copy shop will insure even cuts on the notepaper)

**Steps to Success:**

1. Use the ruler and mark the mid-point on the white sheet of paper with the pencil (horizontal orientation). Ultimately you will cut the paper in half to get two 5.5" wide x 8.5" tall pieces of notepaper.
2. Begin to decorate each half of the paper! Use the sharpie marker to write your ballerina's name across the top; you may choose to write initials or your full name. It may be centered or justified to the top left or top right... or you may do something different on each half of the paper.
3. Use the sharpie to decorate a border. Angelina Ballerina likes to alternate hearts and stars with a rose in each corner.  
Make sure the pencil mark is completely erased on the 'master sheet' once all decorating is complete.
4. Using your 'master sheet,' make photocopies on to the colored paper. Make sure the
5. copier has fresh ink or use a slightly darker setting to insure all the details copy through.
6. Using scissors or paper cutter, cut the paper in half to get your 5.5" wide x 8.5" sheets of notepaper.

*Show you are a true ballerina princess by writing absolutely positively perfect notes!*
